## Activities

### 1. HOW CAN YOU LOVE?

**What you need:** opaque bag, band aid, small packaged snack such as a fruit snack/granola bar/pudding cup, small toy, piece of paper with a heart drawn on it

**What you do:** Place all of the items in a bag and ask your child to pull out one at a time and then share how they might use that item to show love.

Examples:

Food: share a snack with a friend

Band aid: help a friend who is hurt

Toy: share with a new friend

Heart: give someone a hug

**What you say:** "In our Bible story today we learned that Jesus loves everyone! When we follow Him, we can love everyone, too. In this bag I have several items that you can use to show love to others. You can reach into the bag, pick an item, and then tell me how you might use it to show love to someone else. (Do activity.) You have SO many great ideas for showing love to others! I want to follow Jesus every day and show love to everyone, too. Jesus is the BEST leader to follow for sure!"

### 2. HEART CUTOUT

**What you need:** construction paper, marker, preschool-safe scissors

**What you do:** Cut the paper into four equal squares. Fold each square in half. On each paper, draw half of a heart with the middle of the heart at the fold.

**What you say:** "We are going to practice our cutting! Carefully use the scissors to cut on this line. (Do activity.) Great job! Let's unfold the cutout and see what it is! It's a heart! A heart stands for love! Jesus wants us to follow Him and love one another!" (Repeat with other hearts if your child desires.)

### 3. FOLLOW ME

**What you need:** bandana or scarf

**What you do:** Take turns with your child wearing the bandana or scarf as a blindfold. The person who can see carefully leads their partner around the room.

**What you say:** "Let's take turns leading and following! One of us will be blindfolded and we'll hold hands. The one who can see will very carefully guide the one who can't see around the room. (Do activity.) You did an awesome job leading AND following! Super job! Who is the BEST leader to follow? Yes, Jesus! Who can you follow? I can follow Jesus!"
