## Activities

### 1. EVERYWHERE

**What you need:** pre-school safe globe

**What you do:** Ask your child to point to any colored area on the globe. Identify the country your child points to.

**What you say:** "Our Bible story today tells us that we should tell everyone that Jesus is alive. We can tell everyone all around the world! Let's pick a country around the world where we can tell people that Jesus is alive. (Do activity.) We can tell EVERYONE that Jesus is alive! Who is alive? Jesus is alive!"

### 2. WHO AND WHERE CAN WE TELL?

**What you need:** marker and 2 sheets of paper

**What you do:** At the top of one sheet of paper write "WHO" and on the other write "WHERE".

**What you say:** "We learned in our Bible story today that Jesus has given us a very important job! That job is to tell everyone everywhere about Jesus! First, let's talk about WHO we can tell. I've written that word here. Name some people you can tell about Jesus, and I'll write down your answers. Great job! We've listed so many people. Now, let's think about WHERE we go. Name some places you go where you could tell others about Jesus, and I'll write down your answers. As you can see from our papers, there are lots of people in lots of places that we can tell about Jesus! Everyone everywhere needs to hear the good news that Jesus is alive! Who is alive? Jesus is alive!"

### 3. LET'S GO

**What you need:** several stuffed animals and toy cars

**What you do:** Set the stuffed animals on the floor around the activity area, far apart from each other.

**What you say:** "Look at all of your friends around the room! Let's drive our cars to each of them and tell them that Jesus is alive! (Do activity.) Great job driving! We can tell everyone everywhere that Jesus is alive!!"
