Activities

### 1. GOD MADE ME

**WHAT YOU NEED:** sheet of paper, marker, optional stickers of items that God made (flowers, people, animals, sun, moon, stars, etc.)

**WHAT YOU DO:** In large letters, write “God Made” in the center of the paper.

**WHAT YOU SAY:** “Let’s talk about things that God made! Our paper says ‘God Made’, and we’ll add stickers (or draw pictures) of things that He made. I see flowers, people, and many other things! Let’s put all of the stickers onto the paper (or draw pictures of things that we see that God Made)! (Do activity.) Nice work! Look at all of those things that God made! Let’s hang our picture on the refrigerator so that we can enjoy it all week!”

### 2. CREATION CUPS

**WHAT YOU NEED:** plastic drink cups, tissue paper or paper towels, tape or rubber bands, small toy items of things God made (animals, food, people, stars, trees, flowers, etc.)

**WHAT YOU DO:** Place one toy item in each cup. Place tissue paper over the mouth of the cup and secure it with tape or a rubber band.

**WHAT YOU SAY:** “I have a game for us to play! I want you to pick a cup, push your hand through the paper, and pull out what you find inside the cup. (Help your child do the first one.) Look! God made (name the toy object)! That’s so fun! Let’s do the rest! (Each time your child holds up a toy object, say, “God made [name of object]!”) God made all of these things. And guess which one He loves the most? (Hold up a toy person.) People! God loves people. God loves (child’s name). Who loves you? God loves me!”

### 3. MY BODY IS SPECIAL

**WHAT YOU NEED:** no supplies needed

**WHAT YOU DO:** Help your child think of all the awesome things that his/her body parts can do.

**WHAT YOU SAY:** “So, today we learned that God made us. Right? Right! And because God made us, He loves us very much. Right? Right! Well, since God made our bodies, and He loves us, let’s talk about some of our favorite things about our bodies. Think about your body. What is your favorite part? God made your feet to run, and a brain to think, and a tongue to taste yummy food. Let’s name our body parts and then say why we’re so glad God gave them to us! (Do activity.) That was SO great! God gave us such wonderful bodies because He loves us so much! He made us so special! Who loves you? God loves me!”
