Activities

1. DON'T LOSE YOUR CROWN

WHAT YOU NEED: sheet of tissue paper or regular paper

WHAT YOU DO: Challenge your child to place the paper on his/her head and walk around without it falling off.

WHAT YOU SAY: "Let's pretend that we have crowns! Pretend that this paper is your crown. Here's our plan for our crowns: walk around the room with your crown on your head, and try your best not to let it fall! (Do activity.)

Great job! We followed our plan! God has a plan for us, too. Queen Esther followed God's plan, and we can, too! Who loves you? God loves me!"

2. PLAN

WHAT YOU NEED: building blocks

WHAT YOU DO: Ask your child to build a castle with the blocks.

WHAT YOU SAY: "Let's build together! First, we need a plan! We are going to build a castle. Do you have any ideas? Those are awesome ideas! We need to decide what colors of blocks to use, how big we want it to be, and who wants to build which part. We have a plan! Great job! Let's start building! (Do activity.)

WOW! That looks awesome! We followed the plan, and it turned out great! Today we heard about how God had a plan for Esther and how He has a plan for all of us!"

3. CROWN

WHAT YOU NEED: construction or regular paper, scissors, tape, and stickers

WHAT YOU DO: Cut strips of paper and tape them together so that they will fit around your child's head like a crown.

WHAT YOU SAY: "Today, we heard an awesome Bible story about Queen Esther. We are going to make a crown just like Queen Esther's. This will be your crown. Use the stickers to decorate your crown. (Do activity.) WOW! I love your crown! God had a plan for Queen Esther, and He has a plan for us too! Who loves you? God loves me!"
