




WEEK OF JUNE 14TH

FOOD PREP

WHAT YOU NEED: Play-Doh, tools for Play-Doh shaping like rolling pins and play knives

WHAT YOU DO: Supervise your child playing with the Play-Doh.

WHAT YOU SAY: “What is your favorite food? Sometimes we make our favorite foods to celebrate or have a special meal. I want you to shape the Play-Doh in front of you into your favorite food. You can use the rolling pin to roll out your Play-Doh. Then, cut it out or shape your Play-Doh with your hands. (Do activity.) Your Play-Doh food creations are making me hungry! In today’s Bible story, we heard about the special meal that Jesus had with his friends after He came back. They sure did have a lot to celebrate! How happy they must have been to be together again!”



ROCK BIN

WHAT YOU NEED: small bin, 8-10 rocks of differing sizes

WHAT YOU DO: Help your child place the rocks in order of smallest to largest.

WHAT YOU SAY: “I spy some stones! These rocks are all different sizes. Let’s take out the rocks one at a time and put them in a line from smallest to largest. (Do activity.) Nice job! This is the smallest rock (point to the first rock in the line), and this is the largest rock (point to last rock in the line). Today in our Bible story, we talked about the HUGE stone that was rolled away from Jesus’s tomb! It was much bigger than any of these rocks, but still, Jesus came out and came back!”



MEMORY VERSE CRAWL

WHAT YOU NEED: play tunnel OR chairs and blanket to make tunnel

WHAT YOU DO: Set play tunnel on the floor OR drape blanket over chairs to form a tunnel.

WHAT YOU SAY: “Let’s take turns crawling through the tunnel! When you come out and stand up at the other end, we will say our memory verse. It says, ‘These are written (open your hands like a book) so that you (point out) may believe (point to head) that Jesus is the Christ, (point up) the Son of God.’ (Rock baby.) John 20:31. (Open hands like a book.) Great job! Okay, crawl through the tunnel then jump up, and we’ll say our verse together. (Do activity.) When you went into the tunnel, I couldn’t see you until you came out. In our Bible story today, we heard how Jesus went away. His friends were so sad. But then, Jesus came back! Jesus is alive, and we can believe in him. Who can believe in Jesus? I can believe in Jesus!”
