What You Need: An assortment of big and small items

What You Do: Set the big and small items in an area in front of your child. Hold up one big and one small item.

What You Say: 'I have a small item and a big item. Can you point to the small one? Can you point to the big one? Look at the things in front of you. Can you point out all of the big things? Great job! You found all of the big things! Today we are talking about how BIG God's love is for us!

What You Need: Floor tape, mirror

What You Do: Use the floor tape to make a long path across the room. Place the mirror at the end of the path.

What You Say: We have an awesome memory verse this month. Let's walk this path and say our memory verse. (I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Psalm 139:14) When you get to the end of the path, you will see someone who is important to God. When you see who is important to God, say 'Cheese!' We are so important to God that He gave us a wonderful gift - Jesus! Thank you God for giving us Jesus!



MEMORY VERSE MOTIONS

What You Need: Bible

What You Do: Open your Bible to Psalm 139:14.

What You Say: Today's Bible story was about how important you are to God. God loves you SO much, He sent His Son, Jesus, to be your friend forever! That's a lot of love! Do you know why you are so important to God? Because God made you! God made you, and He loves you very much! The Bible verse we are learning tells us how God made you. It says "I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Psalm 139:14.

Let's say that together with the motions:


I am (point thumbs to chest)
