## Summer Day Camp Counselor

Summer Camp Dates: June 1-August 6, 2021

### Qualifications:

- Completion of high school or at least 18 years of age.
- Active Christian faith and a genuine interest in the faith development of children and youth.
- Emotional maturity, good moral character, and integrity.
- Pass a state run background check.

### General Responsibilities:

- Provide leadership and guidance to all campers.
- Take primary responsibility for the health and well-being of campers.
- Enforce the rules and policies of camp.
- Serve as a Christian role model to campers in personal faith, worship, language, appearance, manners, and health habits.
- Complete tasks assigned by the camp leaders and director (e.g. art, devotions, hiking, group projects, etc.).
- Work together with the entire staff for the welfare of the camp and campers.

### Essential Functions of Job:

- Auditory and visual ability to respond to critical incidents.
- Ability to perform routine first aid tasks.
- Ability to observe camper behavior, assess its appropriateness, enforce appropriate safety regulations and emergency procedures, and apply appropriate behavior management techniques.
- Ability to lead and participate in activities that help all campers be involved and have a successful experience.
