



Early Childhood Teacher –Full Time

Beginning in the 2023-2024 Academic Year

Primary Responsibility: A teacher in the Early Childhood Department is responsible for the overall classroom instruction and learning environment.

Qualifications:

- Prior experience working with young children in a formal setting
- Bachelor's Degree in Education or Early Childhood Education is preferred
- Commissioned Minister status through the LCMS is preferred; or synodically-trained
- Active member of an LCMS congregation
- Current First Aid and Infant/Child CPR certification or a commitment to obtain such
- Ability to perform physical duties of the job

Duties:

- Be a Christian role model in attitude, speech, and actions toward others
- Attend school-sponsored events and meetings as directed
- Follow guidelines for faith-based, developmentally appropriate curriculum and practices
- Provide for growth and development in all skill areas, including motor, music, art, science, health, dramatic play, language arts, math readiness, and religion
- Maintain a neat, organized classroom and assist in keeping common areas in good order
- Help students learn classroom procedures, personal responsibility, and respect
- Use appropriate behavior management as outlines in school policies
- Establish and maintain consistent communication with families
- Supervise and work with classroom assistants/aides
- Other duties as assigned by the Early Childhood Director or Principal

Accountability:
