WORSHIP
IT'S MORE THAN YOU THINK

GET TO KNOW EACH OTHER

To make worshiping God the priority in your life, what do you personally need to say "no" to more?

REFLECT ON THE READING

Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me. (John 15:4)

What do these words of Jesus tell you about the importance of worshiping with others: "No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine."

How do you find that worshiping with others strengthens your faith?

DISCUSS THE MESSAGE

Adele Calhoun defines worship as "something that happens when we intentionally cherish God and value Him above all else." How much do you struggle with putting God first in everything?

"The Church" is a collection of people that is comprised of individuals. Reflect on how your personal journey contributes to making Messiah a place where God is glorified.
