DISCUSSION QUESTIONS



LOVE like Jesus

Get to know each other.

If you're a parent, is there any kind of music your kids like to listen to with you? If you're not a parent, do you remember listening to music with your parents?

LEARN from Jesus

In what ways are churches “polluted by the world”?
